## Hello, Grand Isles Residents!

We held our Board of Directors meeting on Thursday, October 14th. The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:04 PM by our President, Doug Stark. With four Board Members in attendance, it was determined that we had a quorum. We waived the reading of the last meeting's minutes and President, Doug Stark signed the last meeting's minutes and gave the Treasurer's Report which is available upon request. Updates were provided on old business and new business. Here are some highlights of the old and new business:

- We are looking forward to having our Halloween Party on Friday, October 27th from 5-9 PM outside the clubhouse. We will have a DJ, LED robot, pumpkin painting station, candy, and a costume contest with 1st and 2nd place gift cards for each group with a 1st place prize of \$75 and 2nd place prize of \$50. There will be 3 age groups for judging which includes the 17+ for the adults that come in costume. We cannot wait to see the great costumes! See the attached flyer for more details.
- Our annual Holiday Party is set for December 9th. Residents will receive free meal tickets for their choice of a Chik Fil-A truck or pizza truck. A dessert truck will be available with items for purchase. Food will be served from 4-8, a family holiday movie at 6:30, and then an adult dance in the clubhouse at 8:30. This will be similar to last year with residents receiving up to four meal tickets per address and we will be providing up to 650 free meals.
- The Harbor Cove and Emerald Point entrances have been beautifully revitalized, and the Carmel entrance is next in line for a refreshing makeover. A declining Sylvester Palm will be replaced at no cost, thanks to our landscape company's guarantee. Our colorful quarterly flowers will be planted within two weeks. Our second round of palm tree trimming is also scheduled before Thanksgiving.
- Our holiday lights were installed and will be lit before Thanksgiving marking the beginning of a joyful season. This year, we're delighted to introduce a new addition to our holiday decorations: blue and white lights. This decision was made in response to requests from community members who celebrate Hanukkah, a significant Jewish holiday that coincides with the Christmas season. The addition of blue and white lights reflects our commitment to creating a welcoming environment for all residents.
- In alignment with our community's governing documents, the Board has approved the removal of all landscaping services for Carmel residents effective January 1, 2024. We will continue to provide irrigation services to Carmel residents and maintenance of the Carmel common areas. This decision was made after careful consideration of various factors, including cost-effectiveness and the desire to empower residents to personalize their landscaping choices. This change will require some adjustments to your existing lawn care services since you are already caring for your side and backyards.
- The discussion regarding the proposed 2024 budget has been temporarily postponed until the next board meeting. This decision was made to address concerns raised by another board member. We value the input of all board members and believe that a fair and thorough discussion on matters of such significance is heard. The revised budget discussion will be held at the next scheduled board meeting as well as the November Election of two board members who are running for re-election.
