Stay Cool, Stay Calm-Don't Break the Security Arm!

Every month, Grand Isles averages three incidents of residents hitting and damaging the security arms at our front and back gates—that's over 30 incidents every year.

While our security cameras help identify drivers and allow us to impose the approximately \$100 fine for each incident—excluding the additional time and money you spend repairing your car—the process takes valuable time away from our property manager and board of directors. Our energy is better spent working on initiatives that improve our community rather than policing careless driving.

The board is actively exploring options to make passage through the gates easier and smoother. However, no improvement will replace the responsibility of each driver to slow down, stay alert, and pass through patiently without causing damage.

Grand Isles HOA – September Meeting Highlights

As we work to increase engagement in the newsletter, we'll now be sharing monthly meeting minutes in a summary format for a quick and easily digestible reading experience, followed by a link to the detailed version on the community website.

Top 5 Highlights from the September 18th, 2025 Board Meeting:

1) Financial Update

• The Association remains on solid financial footing, with total assets of \$1.4M, including nearly \$968K in reserves.

2) Road & Gate Improvements

The Board approved roadway and curb repairs with The Paving Lady. Once
complete, the asphalt rejuvenation project will begin. In addition, gate equipment is
nearing end of life, and proposals for replacement (including evaluation of a
pedestrian gate near Carmel) will follow.

3) Parking Survey

• The community parking survey has received nearly **450 completed submissions**. The survey will remain open until **October 12th**, **2025**, and results will guide future parking policy decisions. **You still have time to participate through** <u>this link!</u>

4) New Capital Contribution Policy

Beginning January 1st, 2026, all new buyers will be required to pay an amount
equal to two months of the Master Association's regular monthly assessments at
the time of closing. This one-time working capital contribution will help
strengthen Association funds without changing regular assessments.

5) Community Engagement & Events

- Online Voting for annual elections is being explored to increase participation.
- Bingo Night was a big success, with another planned on November 7th at 7:00pm.
- The Board is considering Food Truck Nights and will research vendor and permitting requirements.
